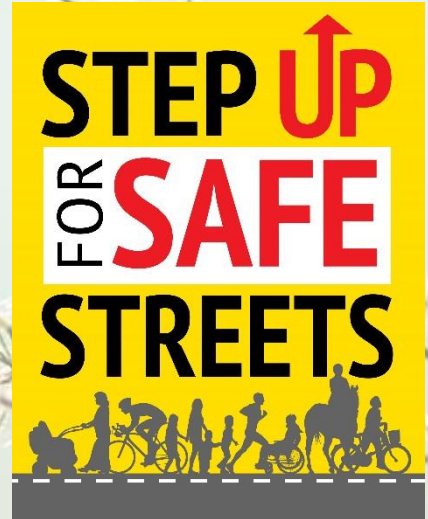


Child Death Prevention Newsletter ...Road Safety Week

This newsletter is designed to raise awareness of the work of the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Child Death Overview Panel (CDOP) and to bring news on our ongoing campaigns.



Tragically, since 2008, the Child Death Panel has reviewed deaths of children from Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent, who have been pedestrians, on bicycles or passengers in cars.

Road Safety Week, coordinated annually by Brake, aims to inspire thousands of schools, organisations and communities to take action on road safety and promote life-saving messages during the week and beyond. It also provides a focal point for professionals working in road safety to boost awareness and engagement in their work.

This years theme is 'Step up for Safe Streets'. Learn about, shout about and celebrate amazing design-led solutions that all us all to get around in safe and healthy ways.

Locally, Road Safety Officers, who deliver training to schools all year round recommend supportive safety information for parents, carers and professionals on the 'Think' road safety website.

Safe+Sound is an initiative co-ordinated through Staffordshire Fire & Rescue Service.
